On this exciting tour you will see the many faces that make up Music City. We begin with a driving tour of Music Row, home of recording studios and music publishing offices. Visit the Ryman Auditorium, one of Nashville's signature historical country music landmarks. Lastly, the Country Music Hall of Fame, the world's largest research center dedicated to a single form of American music. The Hall of Fame provides guests with an in-depth look at the people, places, instruments, and emotions that have contributed to the development of country music.

MANSIONS OF THE SOUTH

Travel back in time to an era literally "Gone with the Wind." Enjoy southern hospitality while touring Nashville's premier antebellum mansion, Belle Meade Plantation. One of the south's most rewarding showplaces, Belle Meade Mansion is known as the "Queen of the Tennessee Plantations." The fully restored manor house and out buildings represent 100 years of Tennessee history and architecture. Enjoy a docent guided tour of the mansion and the grounds. The second stop includes a tour of Belmont Mansion, an ornate Italianate villa built in 1850. Belmont was the summer home of Adelia Acklen, who was reputed to be the wealthiest woman in the United States in the mid-nineteenth century. Hear her real life Scarlet O'Hara story.

Since 1866, the folks in Lynchburg have been making their whiskey by mellowing every drop through hard maple charcoal then aging it for years in charred oak barrels. Folks have been coming to Lynchburg with a thirst to know more about Mr. Jack Daniel and his Tennessee Whiskey. Lynchburg, approximately 70 miles south of Nashville, is the only place this sour mash whiskey is made. Your distillery guide will tour you throughout the grounds including the barrel house and bottling buildings. Step over to the fermenting vats for a quick smell of the raw product that one day will be Tennessee Whiskey. We will lunch at the renowned Miss Mary Bobo's Boarding House. Miss Bobo's is known for her family style service, great southern cooking and having one dish on the menu with a little of the home town product

added in for flavor. Make your way to the General Store where just about any Jack Daniel's logo product you can image is there, except for the product itself. Did we mention that Lynchburg is dry?
